

## Suggested Scripture Readings for the Burial of the Dead

### Old Testament Reading

Psalm 24	<i>They shall receive a blessing from the God of their salvation (24.5)</i>
Psalm 34.1-10,22	<i>Fear the LORD, you saints of the LORD. (34.9)</i>
Psalm 42.1-7	<i>My soul is athirst for God, athirst for the living God; when shall I come to appear before the presence of God? (42.2)</i>
